

CUPE Local 3754 Reaches Agreement

CUPE Local 3754, La Division Scolaire Franco-Manitobaine, reached an agreement on January 16, 2016. This was a difficult round of bargaining as the Local pushed hard for the implement of a Defined Benefits Pension Plan. To counter the Local, the Division had MSBA Director, George Copeland, as their lead negotiator.

The new deal includes two percent (2%) wage increases for each of the first three years, and two increase of one and a half percent (1.5%) in year four. The members will also see an increase of two (2) personal days, and they have set up a committee to look into a defined benefits pension plan.
